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# SECAF & CSAF Goals for Air Force Acquisition



Recapturing acquisition excellence requires an experienced, skilled, empowered, and accountable workforce, and begins with proper requirements and adequate and stable funding.

- Revitalize the Air Force Acquisition Workforce
- Improve Requirements Generation Process
- Instill Budget and Financial Discipline
- Improve Air Force Major Systems Source Selections
- Establish Clear Lines of Authority and Accountability within Acquisition Organizations



# Restrictor Plate Environment



- 4 Mar 2009, President Barack Obama supported bipartisan legislation to reform the defense acquisition process
  - He rejected the “false choice” of deciding between national security and wasting billions of taxpayer dollars.
- Cut \$40 billion in wasteful spending each year
- Developing “tough new guidelines” on contracting by the end of September.



# Restrictor Plate Environment Cont'd



- Increased complexity and scope requires more attention to:
  - Federal Acquisition Processes
  - Federal Acquisition Work Force
  - Stakeholders' Role at Every Level of the Acquisition System
- Acquisition Reform Bill
- Among the reforms in their proposed Weapons Systems Acquisition Reform Act, one would require the Pentagon to conduct preliminary design reviews before giving approval to new acquisition programs.
- Cut \$40 billion in wasteful spending each year



# Challenges



- Challenges facing the 754 ELSG
  - > 45% O&M budget cuts (FY 2006 – 2009)
  - Continuing pressure for personnel reductions
  - Managing a geographically separated workforce
  - Maintaining credibility with our customer
