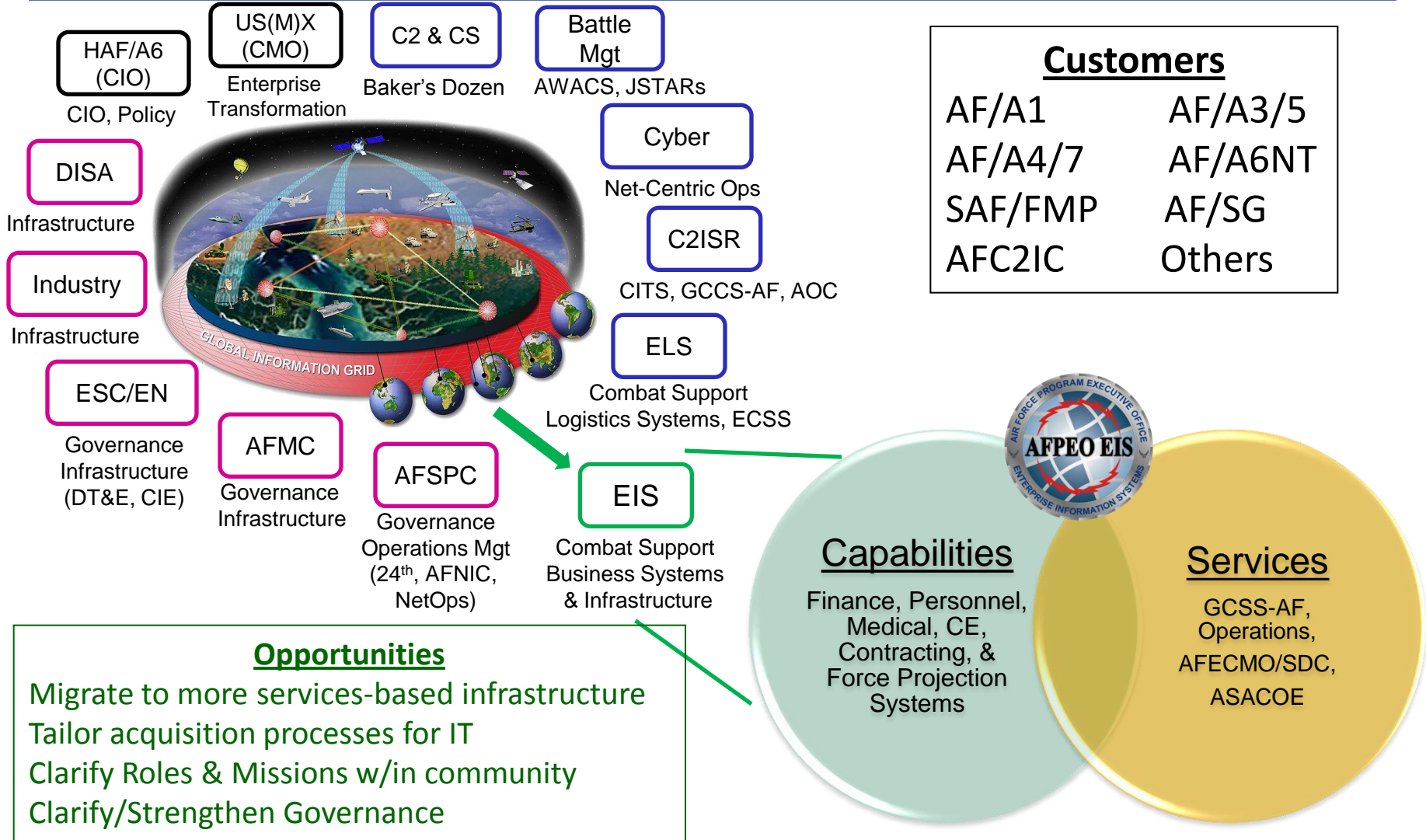
- **1970-1984: Air Force Data System Design Center**

Key Tenets

- Split projects into smaller, simpler segments (18-24 months) with clear deliverables
- Currency with technology

- Measureable requirements (outcome/performance based)
